

Hands-on zebrafish husbandry course 2023

13 - 15 November, Stockholm, Sweden

The zebrafish core facility at Karolinska Institutet, in collaboration with Nord University and Norecopa, would like to invite you to a hands-on zebrafish husbandry course. The aim of the course is to teach evidence-based methods and practical skills for housing and care of zebrafish. Topics will include:

- Biosafety
- Culture of rotifers, including polyculture
- Rearing and keeping zebrafish
- Animal welfare
- Aquatic techniques, including feeding robots
- Minor surgical procedures, including fin-clipping and tattooing
- Cryopreservation of zebrafish lines and IVF (an optional add-on for up to 5 participants on 16 November)

The number of course participants is limited to 10.
